


AIRPORT DINING GUIDES

Here, a round-up of a few choice dining options both in Sea-Tac airport and in the surrounding area. Note that all of the dining options in the airport are past security. While most airport fare is chain-dominated, these are spots that are unique to Puget Sound or representative of Washington in some way. With that said, there is a McDonald's coming to Concourse B in early June. It'll be the first one to arrive at Sea-Tac and one of the most requested options by passengers, according to the airport.
