

**Ivar Haglund's Musical Legacy**

Ivar Haglund was a Seattle character, entrepreneur, entertainer and King of the Waterfront. Ivar established the city's first combination aquarium and fish and chips stand in 1938. When he wasn't opening new restaurants or engaging in colorful civic escapades, Ivar was making music on stage and on local radio and television. He became known as Puget Sound's principal champion of regional folk music. Seattle historian Paul Dorpat has made music with Ivar Haglund over the years, and Paul's recent birthday celebration coincided with the 70th anniversary of the founding of Ivar's restaurants.
